Goolsby Mortuary keeping you aware of Funeral Laws & Practices



We at Goolsby Mortuary are committed to serve you in the most professional and compassionate manner. Therefore, we are compelled to keep you aware of the changes in our industry. Recently, the Governor signed house bill 68 into law which will allow a person 18 or older to direct the location, manner and conditions of the disposition of his or her remains (burial or cremation). The arrangements are not subject to cancellation or substantial revision unless ordered by a person appointed in the pre-need contract to do so, or unless set-aside resources are insufficient. The bill specifies who can control disposition and grants the majority rule among next of kin with like degree of relationship. It will allow the families to proceed when there are missing or estranged heirs if reasonable attempts of contact have been made. It places the burden on the person signing disposition authorization as warranting truthfulness as to next of kin, identity of deceased, related facts; and, releases the funeral home from liability when people fraudulently represent next of kin.
